

How to apply for a place in Reception

If you live in Cumbria and your child was born between 1 September 2011 and 31 August 2012, you must apply to Cumbria County Council (Local Authority) for a school place, under the Local Authority's Co-ordinated Admissions Scheme.

Threlkeld School holds an open morning for prospective parents and pupils in November.

1. If your child attends a pre-school setting e.g. a nursery you will be given an information sheet. If you attend Threlkeld School Parent and Toddler Group (which runs on Monday mornings) we will pass on this information sheet. If your child has a sibling already attending Threlkeld School, we will ensure you receive the information sheet.
2. Please apply on-line if possible. The on-line application form can be found on Cumbria County Council's website at:

The closing date for applications is in January each year.

3. Once you have received confirmation from School Admissions that your child has a Place at Threlkeld (this will happen in April), we will send you details of two New Starter Mornings. The first in June is for both parents and children. Parents will be given more information about school life.
The second date is an opportunity for children to be left with their new teachers and classmates for an hour or so.
