

How Threlkeld School have spent the PE Premium to date

Threlkeld School received £8320 PE and Sport Premium funding for 2015/16 academic year, the funding has been and will be used in the following ways:

1. Keswick School Partnership

Threlkeld and three other local Primary Schools have bought into a 1 day a week package with Keswick School our local secondary school. Keswick School host and organise a variety of sports tournaments / festivals across all age groups and provides expert coaching for children and staff (in school and at after school clubs). A designated specialist PE Teacher from Keswick School, supported by a group of young sports leaders, provide this service for us. For provision see the calendar of events arranged with Keswick School.

2. Allerdale School Sports Partnership

Allerdale organise expert coaches to provide 4 blocks, of 1 hour per week sessions, for a duration of 5/6 week in a combination of curriculum and afterschool clubs. 2015-2016 coaches have delivered and are due to delivered: Tennis, kinder cricket, kwik cricket and multi-skills. Allerdale also organise district competitions and tournaments for the winners of local primary school events.

3. Staff inset training (including supply cover)

Swimming, gymnastics and competitive games.

4. Cybercoach Membership

Provides online fun and physical activities, such as wake and shake, PE/dance classes, wet play and after school club resources.

5. Local Rugby Coach

All KS2 pupils benefit from a specialist rugby coach, who trains the children to play 'Touch Rugby' on a weekly basis throughout the summer term.

6. Extra swimming instructors

Year 2- 6 have 20 sessions and Reception/Year 1 have 6 sessions of swimming over the academic year.

7. Replacement of old resources

The Impact on the school of the PE Premium

-Teachers are more confident about teaching gymnastics and the quality of teaching and learning has improved. Threlkeld's gymnastic team have successfully competed in local schools competition and individual pupils won places in the top three for the overall pupil award.

-Teachers are more confident about teaching dance having worked in partnership with a dance specialist to participate in the U-Dance festival at the Theatre by the Lake. Children were motivated by the outcomes of the project: dance/performance, DVD and participation rates for dance (particularly for boys) has increased.

-Pupils are now taught in smaller swimming groups and there are more staff trained to teach swimming. Pupils have enhanced teaching and learning opportunities resulting in more rapid development of swimming skills.

-Better quality equipment has motivated and increased physical activity participation of children.

-Children have received expert coaching in football, tennis, gymnastics, multi-skills, cricket and have an increased number of festivals in which to take part. Expectations of children and staff have increased resulting in enhanced performance overall.

-The use of cyber coach has increased quality, quantity and range of physical activities within the school. Teachers and teaching assistants are more confident to deliver a variety of activities with this online resource.

-The introduction of sports weeks aims to improve the engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity and kick-starting healthy active lifestyles. Also the profile of PE and sport will be raised across the whole school.
