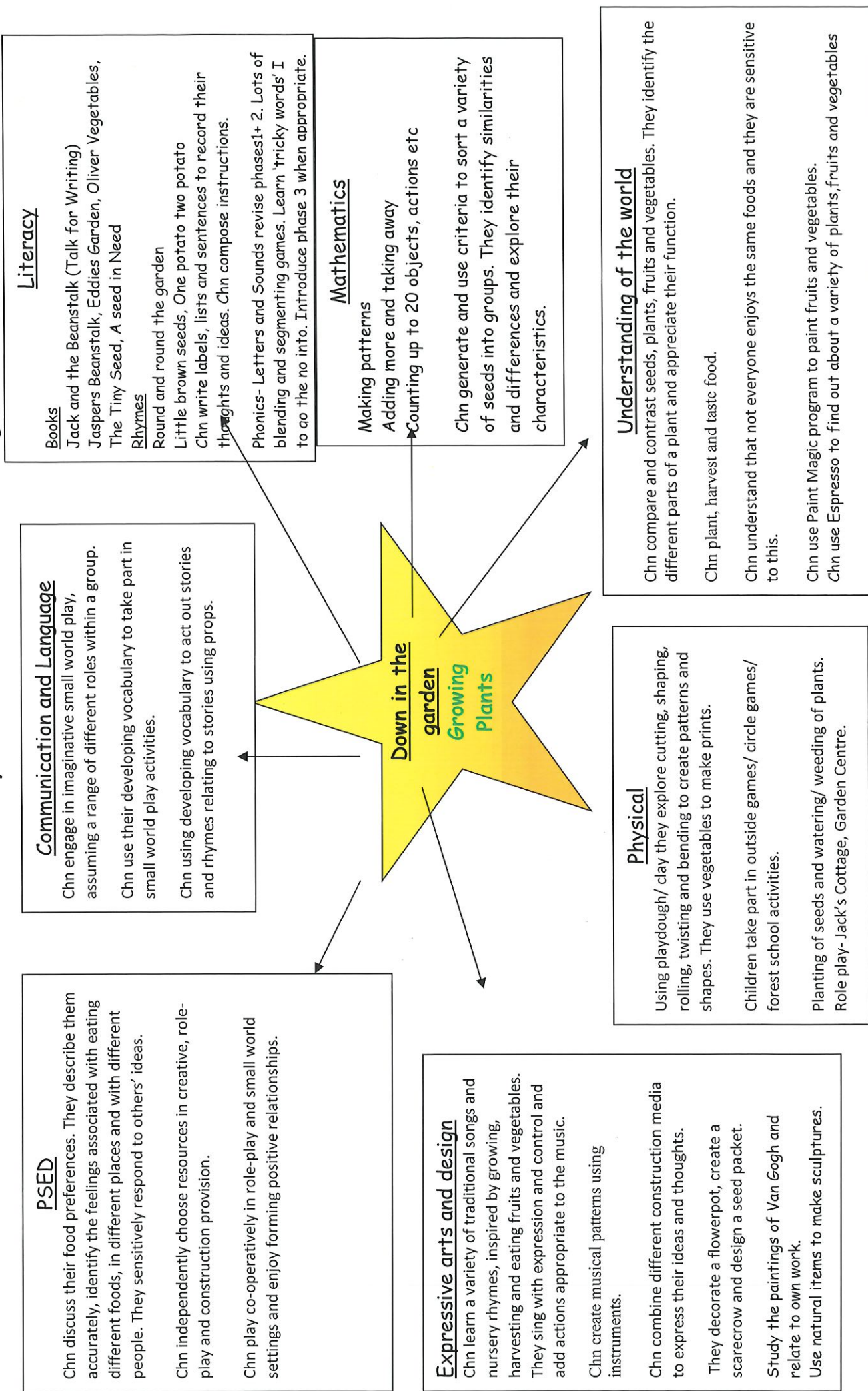

Use of simple symbols and key

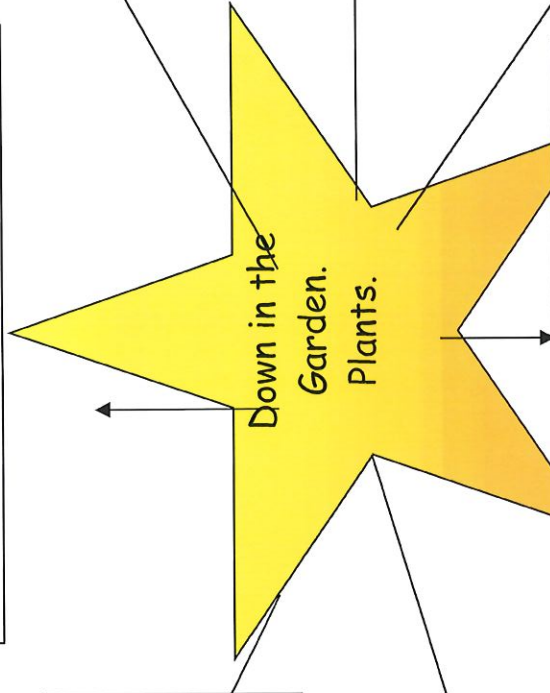
D&T

Revise phonic phases 3,4,5.  
Books - Jack and the Beanstalk(Talk for Writing), Jaspers Beanstalk, Eddies Garden, Oliver's Vegetables, The Tiny Seed, Beatrix Potter stories.  
Rhymes- Rhymes about seeds and Plants.

Numeracy (Y1)  
Count in multiples of twos, fives and tens.  
Solve one step problems involving multiplication and division, by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays with the support of the teacher.  
Investigate halves and quarters.  
Describe position, direction and movement including turns.
