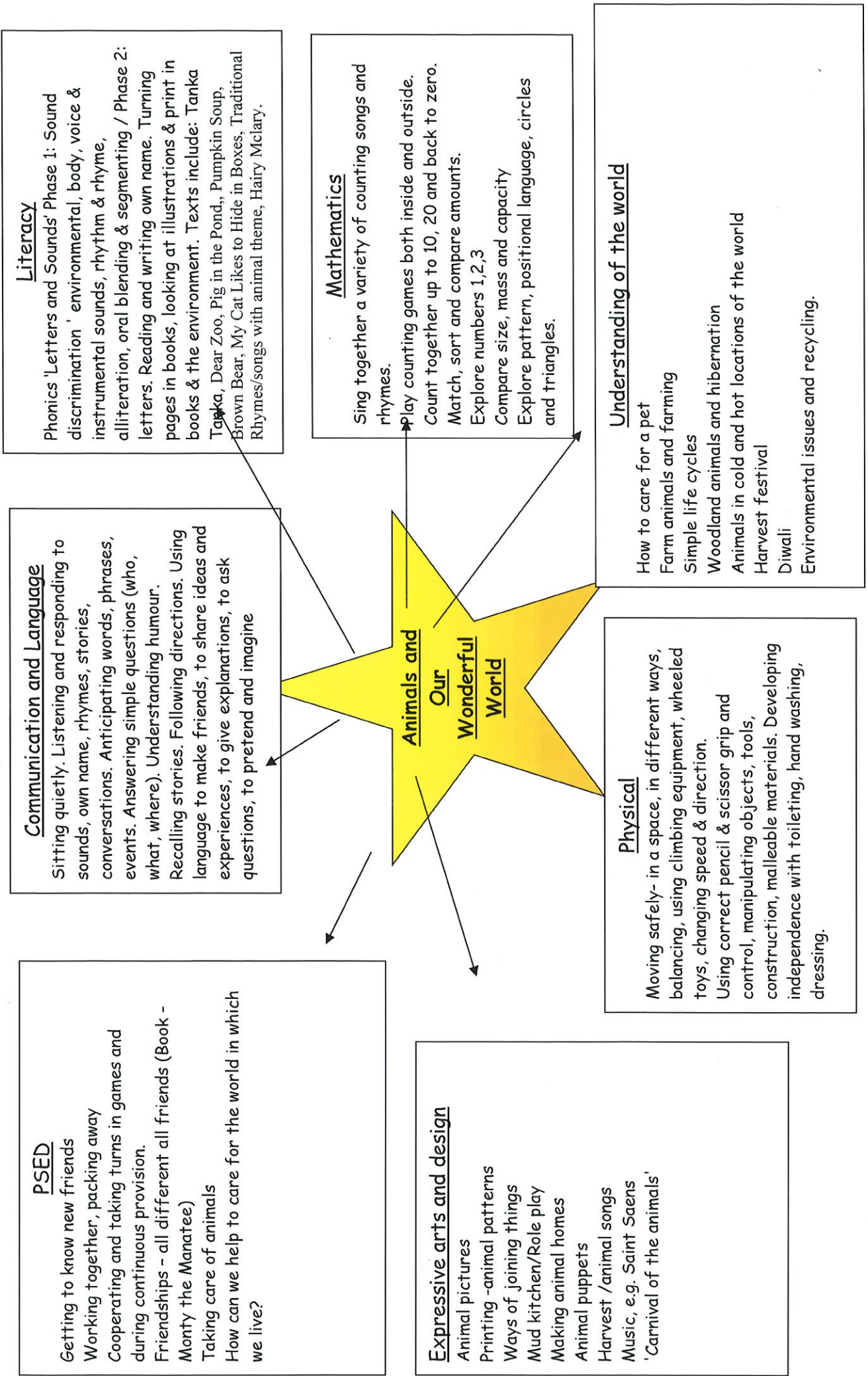

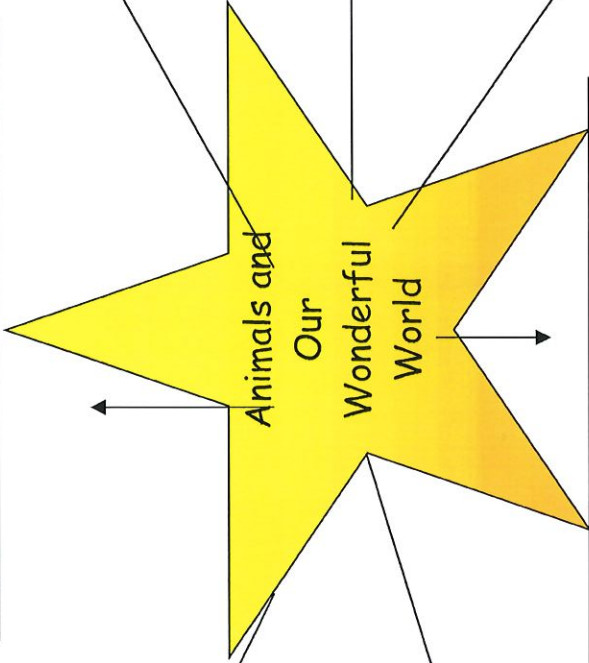
Geography
